 BOOTH SPACE ASSIGNED ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS**

The Pleasanton Downtown Association provides the 10' x 10' space(s). **It is the responsibility of each participant to provide and set up their own equipment (tent / canopy, power [must use whisper quiet generator which does not emit noxious fumes], tables, chairs, etc.).**

NOTE: Selling or giving away any type of food or drink, including candy and water, may require a health permit and an awning.

You should contact Alameda County to find out if you are required to obtain a Temporary Event Health Permit. If you do not have a permit at the event, the County Health Inspector can close down your booth or fine you.
